

St Mary's is currently renewing its Electoral Roll.

This is the basic list which every Church of England parish has of all those entitled to vote in elections within that Church. Those entitled to have their names on this roll have to be 16 years of age or more and they must reside in the relevant parish or be regular worshippers in church whose roll they wish to join.

The roll is completely renewed every six years, at which point all members have to re-apply for membership or else their names will be deleted. By this means, the continuing validity of the roll is maintained. It is a sign of commitment to the parish church to which we belong and to what it stands for. It means that we can have voting rights at the Annual Parochial Church Meeting (APCM) which this year will take place April 14th.

Forms for registration are available at St Mary's, or can be downloaded from the link below, but they will need to be signed and physically returned to the Church no later than Sunday 17 March. The anonymous ethnic monitoring form can also be downloaded and should be returned at the same time.
